Formed in 1818 from the western portion of Warrick County, Vanderburgh County was named in honor of Judge Henry Vanderburgh, one of the territorial judges and early settlers of Indiana. The County has been an XSoft™ client since 2016 and currently maintains approximately 80,000 parcels using a combination of integrated **XSoft CAMA™**, **XSoft Tax™**, and **Engage™** software.
